The SECO program is the primary source of education, career, employment counseling, and scholarship financial assistance for all military spouses, while MyCAA provides a record of educational endeavors and progress of military spouses participating in education services and manages tuition assistance scholarship, tracks enrollments and funding, and facilitates communication with participants. Eligible spouses can use MyCAA to browse approved institutions who offer MyCAA-accepted Career Fields and Occupations, create a customized Education and Training Plan (ETP), submit a Financial Assistance (FA) document, message Career Coaches via the MyInbox, and more. Spouses can also use MySECO to access talent assessments, Virtual Hiring Fairs (VHF), live chats with Career Coaches, MyCAA registration, MyInbox, MSEP job search, customized articles, and much more. The SECO/MyCAA systems also provides Career Coaches, Military Spouse Employment Partnership (MSEP) Specialists, Billing and Help Desk technicians, System Administrators, and MC&FP Program Officers with a central location for SECO, MyCAA, and MSEP program management. This includes account and case management or strain and content management, and financial management, along with statistical analysis, tracking, reporting, program effectiveness evaluations, research, and surveys in order to inform departmental decisions on military support and benefits policy. Personal information collected in the system concerning the military spouse includes: Name, DoD ID number, date of birth, gender, contact information such as address, email address, and phone numbers; years as military spouse; previous work experience, education, certificates and licenses; security clearance; skills, abilities, and competencies, user account information and any unique identifying user number assigned to the military spouse.
