DEPARTMENT OF DEFENSE ANNOUNCES RECRUITING AND RETENTION NUMBERS FOR FISCAL YEAR 2020

The Department of Defense (DoD) today announced recruiting and retention statistics for the Active and Reserve Components for fiscal year 2020.

• Pandemic's Impact.

The Services' continuing efforts helped to mitigate the impacts of the COVID-19 pandemic on the enlisted recruiting enterprise. Adjustments have been made and foremost is the safety and well-being of Service members, their families, and potential recruits. Collectively, these efforts ensure the force is manned while maintaining the right balance of protecting our people and protecting America.

• Active Component.

- o **Recruiting.** The data below represents the Services' cumulative monthly goals and monthly accessions/gains for fiscal year 2020.
 - Army Accessions: Goal 61,200; Attained 61,249 (100.08 percent/+49).
 - Navy Accessions: Goal 39,600; Attained 39,678 (100.20 percent/+78).
 - Marine Corps Accessions: Goal 28,028; Attained 28,048; (100.07 percent/+20).
 - Air Force Accessions: Goal 26,373; Attained 26,373 (100.00 percent).
- O Quality. All Active Components met or exceeded the DoD quality benchmarks.
- o **Retention**. All Services achieved FY2020 retention targets in the aggregate.

• Reserve Component.

- Recruiting. The Service data below represents the Reserve Components' cumulative
 monthly goals and monthly accessions/gains through the ninth month of fiscal year 2020,
 August 2020.
 - Army NG Gains: Goal 42,730; Attained 38,513 (90.13 percent/-4,217).
 - Army Reserve Gains: Goal 15,850; Attained 13,660 (86.18 percent/-2,190).
 - Navy Reserve Gains: Goal 5,907; Attained 5,728 (96.97 percent/-179).
 - Marine Corps Reserve Gains: Goal 5,423; Attained 5,485 (101.14 percent/+62).
 - Air NG Gains: Goal 9,098; Attained 9,406 (103.39.percent/+308).
 - Air Force Reserve Gains: Goal 5,950; Attained 5,856 (98.42 percent/-94).
- Quality. All Reserve Components met or exceeded the DoD quality benchmarks.
- Attrition. The Reserve Components year-to-date attrition percentages were at or above planned target levels for August FY 2020. Five of the six Reserve Components project to meet annual attrition targets in FY 2020 (data lags by one month).
