DEPARTMENT OF DEFENSE ANNOUNCES RECRUITING AND RETENTION NUMBERS FOR FISCAL YEAR 2023 THRU NOVEMBER 2022

The Department of Defense (DoD) today announced recruiting and retention statistics for the Active and Reserve Components thru the second month of fiscal year (FY) 2023.

• Recruiting Market.

The broader recruiting market continues to present a significant challenge to the Department and the Services. Each Service continues, both collaboratively and independently, to explore new ways to reach today's youth. To be successful, they must be able to engage youth and share the opportunities available in today's military.

• Active Component.

- **Recruiting.** The data below represents the Services' cumulative goals and accessions/gains through November 2022, the second month of FY2023.
 - Army Accessions: Goal 10,479; Attained 7,053; (67.31 percent/-3,426).
 - Navy Accessions: Goal 5,624 Attained 3,635; (64.63 percent/-1,989).
 - Marine Corps Accession: Goal 3,486; Attained 3,487 (100.00 percent/+1).
 - Air Force Accessions: Goal 4,241; Attained 3,980; (93.85 percent/-261).
 - Space Force Accessions: Goal 82; Attained 82; (100.00 percent/+0).
- **Quality.** Army and Navy Active Components did not meet the DoD quality benchmarks through November 2022.
- **Retention**. All Services exhibited strong retention during the second month of FY2023 as they exceeded their mission year-to-date (YTD) goals.

• Reserve Component.

- **Recruiting.** The Service data below represents the Reserve Components' cumulative goals and accessions/gains for FY2023 through November 2022.
 - Army NG Gains: Goal 5,589; Attained 4,870 (87.14 percent/-719).
 - Army Reserve Gains: Goal 2,015 Attained 1,362 (67.59 percent/-653).
 - Navy Reserve Gains: Goal 1,439; Attained 771 (53.58 percent/-668).
 - Marine Corps Reserve Gains: Goal 1,144; Attained 1,512 (132.17 percent/+368).
 - Air NG Gains: Goal 1,700; Attained 814 (47.88 percent/-886).
 - Air Force Reserve Gains: Goal 1,351; Attained 777 (57.51 percent/-574).
- **Quality.** Of the Reserve Components, only Marine Corps Reserve, Air Force Reserve, and Air National Guard met or exceeded the DoD quality benchmarks in November.
